Technique beginner

No prior knowledge required. Participants must not be afraid of heights or suffer from

vertigo. Safety: fully secured route with steel cables, iron rungs, bars and

ladders. Terrain: brief exposed vertical sections (K1-2)

Condition beginner

Duration from 2 to 5 hours, up to approx. 700 vertical meters, approx. 250 vertical

meters per hour.
