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Program

- Day 1** The participants meet up in Andermatt and are greeted by the guide. After everyone has collected their rental gear, it's time to head out. The guide will introduce you to using emergency equipment and teach you the basics both on and off the piste.
- Day 2** Have fun skiing one of the countless descents in the Gemsstock, Nätschen and Oberalp areas. The course is tailored to work on your individual strengths and weaknesses, offering you the ideal opportunity to improve your skiing technique.
